Workshop "Nuclear Security Culture: Experience Sharing and Best Practice Exchange." Sao Paulo, Brazil; August 20-24, 2018

Agenda

This workshop will provide training on three distinct themes of nuclear security: (1) the concept of nuclear security (NS) and nuclear security culture (NSC); (2) the IAEA methodology of NSC self-assessment; and (3) nuclear security culture enhancement and sustainability. Through this workshop we will be developing expertise and skills on nuclear security culture based on the IAEA guidance publications, in particular the recently released "IAEA Technical Guidance for Self-Assessment of Nuclear Security Culture in Facilities and Activities" (Nuclear Security Series No. 28-T). To this end, the workshop agenda includes not only modules and interactive exercises (participants are divided into groups) on the use of the IAEA methodology but also presentations/discussion by two national experts from Indonesia and Bulgaria who can provide their first-hand experience after applying this self-assessment methodology in their national settings.

The team of instructors includes Dr. Igor Khripunov, consultant to the IAEA and nonresident fellow at the Center for International Trade and Security at the University of Georgia (USA); Bayu Purnomo of the Center for Security Culture and Self-Assessment at Indonesia's National Atomic Energy Agency (BATAN); and Vladimir Yankov, Head of Analysis and Control of Physical Protection at Kozloduy Nuclear Plant (Bulgaria).

The workshop is funded and organized by the US Partnership for Nuclear Threat Reduction (PNTR) and organized by Civil Research and Development Foundation. (CRDF Global).
